1. The NATO Centre of Excellence for Military Medicine (NATO MILMED COE) is pleased to announce the first iteration of the NATO Medical Support Experimenter Course. The experience gained in Vigorous Warrior Exercises 2017 and 2019 is that the Medical Staff supporting Medical Concept Development & Experimentation (CD&E) lacks the foundational understanding of NATO CD&E policy. Basic understanding and knowledge of NATO CD&E concepts is an essential prerequisite for successful planning, designing and conduction of medical support experiments.

2. **The aim** is to provide basic knowledge on the NATO Medical CD&E process to SMEs who will assist with the planning, design, and conduct of medical support experiments, to include the intended training audience.

3. **Training audience:**

- military medical personnel interested or involved in CD&E activities, especially those who plan to support, facilitate, or participate in medical support experiments during exercises and/or as stand-alone events
- exercise planners who are engaged with National and Multinational exercises

4. **The depth of knowledge** is 200 – assist

5. **Format** - online course. There will be self paced lessons available on JADL website combined with online VTC lectures given by experts from NATO.


6. **Date** – 2-day lasting course to be held on **12 – 13 October 2021**
